

RESOLUTION No. 2018-011918(1)

A RESOLUTION OF THE UPPER CAPTIVA FIRE PROTECTION AND RESCUE SERVICE DISTRICT OF LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSITION OF CERTAIN SURPLUS FIXED ASSETS AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Florida Statute 274 defines procedures for government units to dispose of surplus property; and

WHEREAS, the UPPER CAPTIVA FIRE PROTECTION AND RESCUE SERVICE DISTRICT of Lee County, Florida has identified certain property as being either obsolete, uneconomical, inefficient or serves no useful function and is therefore declared surplus property, and

WHEREAS, Florida Statute 274 identifies the methods for disposition of surplus property as being either by sale, donation to another governmental unit or to a private nonprofit agency as defined in s. 273.01(3), F.S, or may be destroyed or abandoned depending on the value and condition of the property; and

WHEREAS, the following property is identified as surplus and each items' respective original value, acquisition date, current net book value, condition and method for disposition is reflected below:
