

AT APPROXIMATELY 2332, AN ALARM WAS RECEIVED OF A STRUCTURE FIRE AT SOL VISTA/POINT HOUSE TRAIL. RESPONDING UNITS E191, B192, T191, U191 ARRIVED ON SCENE TO FIND A 3 STORY STILT HOME WELL INVOLVED WITH FIRE. FLAMES WERE VISIBLE ON ALL THREE FLOORS AND THROUGH THE ROOF. PROPANE TANKS UNDER THE HOUSE WERE VENTING. A THIRD ALARM WAS IMMEDIATELY TRANSMITTED TO LEE CONTROL, WHO DISPATCHED THE MERT AND NORTH STRIKE TEAM OF ENGINES.

UC-2, 3, AND 4 RESPONDED TO THE SCENE IN MA192. UPON ARRIVAL, MA192 FOUND A 3 STORY WOODFRAME STRUCTURE COMPLETELY COLLAPSED TO THE STILTS, AND AN EXPOSURE 2 STORY HOUSE FULLY INVOLVED. ENG191 WAS WORKING ON ESTABLISHING A SECURE WATER SUPPLY, WHILE CAPTIVA ENG181 FOUGHT THE FIRE IN THE EXPOSURE HOUSE. ALL UCFRD UNITS WERE USED TO PROVIDE TANK WATER TO THE FIRE FOR INITIAL KNOCK DOWN.

UC-2 ASSUMED COMMAND, UC-3 ASSUMED OPS, AND UC-4 ASSUMED ACCOUNTABILITY.

CAPE MARINE 7, IONA MARINE 70, BOCA GRANDE MARINE 231, CHARLOTTE COUNTY MARINE UNIT, AND CAPE MARINE 1 ALL TOOK PART IN ESTABLISHING WATER SUPPLIES FROM SAFETY HARBOR AND THE PINE ISLAND SOUND. ONCE WATER SUPPLY WAS ESTABLISHED, 6 LINES WERE PLACED IN OPERATION WITH MANPOWER UTILIZED FROM THE ARRIVAL OF THE NORTH STRIKE TEAM OF ENGINES. ALL OCCUPANTS OF THE STRUCTURES IN DANGER WERE EVACUATED BY LCSO AND WERE ACCOUNTED FOR. NO ONE WAS REPORTED INSIDE EITHER OF THE HOUSES OF FIRE. ONE FAMILY WAS DISPLACED FROM THE SECOND HOUSE BUT WERE PLACED IN ANOTHER RENTAL THE NEXT DAY. MULTIPLE LP TANKS WERE EXPLODING, IGNITING AND OFFGASING THROUGHOUT THE ENTIRE FIRE.

ISLAND GIRL CHARTER SERVICES WERE ABLE TO CAPTAIN 3 VESSELS FOR THIS FIRE TO SHIP MANPOWER, TOOLS, AND REHAB SUPPLIES FROM PINELAND MARINA.

NORTH STRIKE TEAM:

TICE ENG 212, LEHIGH ENGINE 102, PINE ISLAND 1, PINE ISLAND ENG 153, NORTH BC 1, NORTH ENG 1, NORTH 9, BAYSHORE 1, BAYSHORE ENG 131, CAPE ENG 3, CAPE MARINE 3, FORT MYERS 4, FORT MYERS ENG 11, FORT MYERS ENG 16, BOCA GRANDE MARINE 231, CHARLOTTE MARINE 1, FORT MYERS SHORES 5.

ONCE STRIKE TEAMS ARRIVED, HOSELINES WERE IN PLACE, AND WATER SUPPLY WAS SUFFICIENT FOR ADEQUATE EXTINGUISHMENT, CREWS WERE ROTATED REGULARLY AND REHABED ACCORDING TO LEE COUNTY PROCEDURES AND RECOMMENDATIONS.

SOUTH STRIKE TEAM OF ENGINES WERE DISPATCHED TO PINELAND MARINA BY LEE CONTROL TO PROVIDE RELIEF FOR THE WORKING CREWS AND EXTENSIVE OVERHAUL.

SOUTH STRIKE TEAM:

IONA MARINE 70, IONA ENG 71, IONA ENG 75, IONA 6, SANIBEL LADDER 171, SANIBEL MARINE 171, CAPTIVA ENG 181, FORT MYERS BEACH ENG 32, ESTERO BATT 40, ESTERO ENG 44, SAN CARLOS 4, SAN CARLOS ENG 52, SOUTH TRAIL 5, SOUTH TRAIL 6, SOUTH TRAIL ENG 61

UPON "FIRE UNDER CONTROL", INITIAL HOUSE WAS COMPLETELY DESTROYED AND THE SECOND HOUSE WAS COLLAPSED TO THE FIRST FLOOR. FIRE UNDER CONTROL CAME AT 0132 HRS. ONE PROPANE TANK CONTINUED TO OFFGAS, BUT HAD NO IGNITION SOURCES NEARBY. ONE LINE REMAINED IN SERVICE CONTROLLING THE HEAT OF THE TANK, WHILE THE OTHERS WERE BUSY WITH MOP UP AND OVERHAUL.

LEE COUNTY ARSON TASK FORCE ARRIVED AND BEGAN THEIR INVESTIGATION. STATE FIRE MARSHAL ARRIVED LATER IN THE MORNING FOR THEIR INVESTIGATION.

AFTER ALL STRIKE TEAM UNITS CLEARED, ISLAND GIRL BROUGHT THEM BACK TO PINELAND MARINA. ALL UPPER CAPTIVA UNITS REMAINED ON SCENE FOR EXTENSIVE OVERHAUL. ONCE COMPLETED ASSIGNMENT, ALL UNITS WERE PLACED BACK IN SERVICE.
